TO THE APPLICANT: This is an application for a Zone Boundary Change or Zone Change as authorized by Chapter 17.96 of Ordinance No. 1160 N.S., Title 17, Colville Municipal Code. Please complete the application in its entirety.

The application shall be accompanied by a receipt from the City Treasurer in the amount of five hundred dollars (\$500) for payment of the application fee, and by an accurate map showing the affected property and all other properties within 300 feet, not including street rights-of-way, of the boundaries of the subject property. Addressed, pre-stamped (not metered) envelopes shall be provided by the applicant.

Pursuant to the State Environmental Policy Act (WAC 197-11), an environmental checklist shall be completed and submitted along with a receipt from the City Treasurer in the amount of one hundred twenty-five dollars (\$125). Required publication of the threshold determination will be at cost at the applicant's expense.
