**Scope:** The following work may be available on the City of Colville's Small Works Roster: asbestos removal; asphalt paving; bathroom installation; building construction; building demolition; building repairs; carpentry/framing; carpet laying; CIPP sewer line repair; concrete flatwork; concrete road paving; contaminated soil removal; curb; gutter and sidewalk; diving/salvage; dredging; herbicide/pesticide spraying; decorative concrete; electrical; electrical high voltage; fencing; fire protection systems; flood cleanup/pumping; grading/excavating site work, including tree and/or vegetation removal; handiwork; hazardous waste disposal; hauling snow; HVAC; hydraulics/pneumatics; hydroseed/turf; janitorial/custodial cleaning; landscaping/vegetation management; metal building erection; non-motorized trail construction; painting; pavement striping/road markings; pavement crack sealing; pile driving; pipe bursting; playground equipment; plumbing; pump installation; rockeries; railroad track/tie removal/salvage; roofing; sewer line rehabilitation; street signage; siding; signs; steel and aluminum metal fabrication and machining; structural concrete; tank cleaning; trenching; trenchless underground utility construction and/or repair; underground utility construction and repair; underwater inspection; voice and data telecom/cable wiring; welding.

In order to qualify, the following requirements must be met:

- 1) applicant must be a registered contractor in good standing in the State of Washington with a UBI number and Contractor's License number;
- 2) applicant must be able to comply with Federal and State prevailing wage requirements as they apply to each project;
- 3) applicant must be able to provide bid bonds, payment bonds, performance bonds and a certificate of insurance naming the City of Colville as additional insured when called for;
- 4) applicant must complete and submit a 2010 Small Works Roster Application

Award of contract procedure is described in Section 15.15 of the Colville Municipal Code.
