PLEASE QUOTE ON THE FOLLOWING: Clearing snow and piling it for removal by the City Street Department in the City-owned parking lot located to the north of the Town Center lot (see attached map). Plowing will be done around any parked cars in the area to be plowed. All snow plowing will be completed by 7:00 a.m. Snow plowing will be done for accumulations of one inch (1") or more of snow. Application of Magnesium Chloride or any other de-icing material is not covered under this contract. Quotes should be submitted as hourly rates for snow plowing.

All responses to quotations must be received by **THE CITY CLERK'S OFFICE** no later than 12:00 p.m. on October 16, 2018.
