Main Street Improvement Survey

The City of Colville is currently conducting a survey to identify priorities to develop a long term strategic plan. In the interest of making all voices heard, the Colville Chamber of Commerce Downtown Committee has designed a survey based on the specific needs for Downtown Colville.

A list of potential projects have been compiled by the Chamber Downtown Committee. Grade the following proposed projects, (1 through 8), as to their level of importance, with (1) being the highest, and (8) being the lowest. This survey will then be turned over to the City of Colville, and the Chamber Board to make their recommendations.

- _____ Pedestrian Safety. Improve Crosswalks from Second to Birch Street. Extending "Bulb – Outs" and shortening crosswalk length.
 - _____ Pedestrian Crossing Lights. Add pedestrian controlled crossing lights at the intersections of First & Main, and at Birch & Main Street.
 - _____ Increase Parking at Second & Main. Purchase and re-open 30 space parking lot next to Goodwill and Colville Monument Works. (Funds currently available through Parking Commission).
 - _____ Replace Aging Street Trees. The aging and overgrown street trees require replacement before they damage sidewalks and adjacent buildings. To be replaced with a more street appropriate variety of tree.
 - _____ Remodel Heritage Court to make it more appealing. The current "Heritage" or "Rotary" Court on Aster between Main & Wynne is in need of an upgrade to make it more appealing and user friendly.
 - _____ Close Aster Street between Main & Oak, and turn it into a park.
 - _____ Build a Raised, Concrete "Speed Table" across Main Street, at Aster Street.
