Background of Situation:

Ms Wichmann's Residency at Colville Junior High School will be multi-faceted. All events that involve Patricia will be free and open to the public. The events will include a jazz workshop, a voice master class covering vocal pedagogy with an emphasis on production of correct vowel sounds, a music production workshop, and a Meet the Artist session. Also Ms Wichmann, in collaboration with the Colville High School Jazz Festival, will bring jazz vocals to the Festival.

The Artist-In-Residence event will provide an opportunity for Colville High School and Colville Junior High School students, as well as members of the public to interact with a "local" who is currently a professional artist.

The high school students, junior high school students, and general public will miss an opportunity to experience the performance of a very talented vocalist and composer.

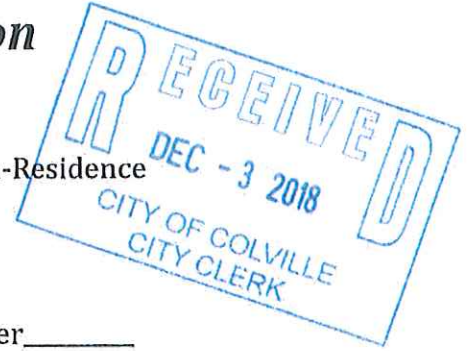

Event / Project Partners: Colville Junior High School and CHS Colville Jazz Festival. If funded, Patricia will spend Thursday afternoon/evening and Friday at Colville High School, as part of Colville Jazz Fest and Monday at CJHS in a jazz, voice and music production residency.

Describe the Event / Project and how it will support cultural vitality in the Colville area:

Patricia Wichmann is a 2006 graduate of Northport High School (graduating class of 11) and the daughter and former student of Carol Wichmann. As a middle and high school student, Patricia was active in her school music program and the lead vocalist in the band "Columbia Rock", which she founded during high school and performed with in the greater Stevens County area. On graduating from NHS, Patricia attended WSU where she majored in Vocal Performance. After graduation, she attended the prestigious Manhattan School of Music in New York City where she obtained a Master of Music in Jazz Voice.

Patricia's Residency at CJHS and CHS will be multi-faceted. At CHS, master classes in jazz and vocals in collaboration with the CHS Jazz Festival will bring jazz vocals to the Festival. Patricia has previously performed and studied with several of the WSU professors who will be attending CHS Jazz Festival. At CJHS, all events that involve Patricia will be free and open to the public. This will include a Monday morning jazz workshop with CJHS Jazz 1, a voice master class covering vocal pedagogy with a specific emphasis on production of correct vowel sounds, and a music production workshop and Meet The Artist session in the afternoon. In addition, Patricia may do several private coaching sessions with students specifically interested in voice or music production. Between CJHS and CHS, Patricia will interact with >200 young musicians in the course of several days, in addition to members of the public at various Jazz Festival and Residency events. The students will interact with a "local" who is currently a professional artist.

The CJHS Music Department and Colville School District will provide in-kind contributions of publicity and advertising, a performance venue and sound and light services through the high school Auditorium Tech crew, classroom facilities for master classes, and ground transportation, food and the bulk of the lodging for the artist.





CJHS Music Department agrees to provide travel, food, lodging, meals and \$750 in compensation through the Vinson Fund and \$200 through CJHS Music.


