Topic or Problem Statement: 2017 Sanitation Rate Ordinance

Type of Briefing:

Information Only Discussion Only Decision Needed

Background of Situation:

Each year, per contract with Sunshine Disposal, a rate increase is allowed at 85% percent of the previous 12 months average CPI. Stevens County Solid Waste has also implemented an increase in tipping fees at the landfill. Stevens County adopted a \$3.50 per ton increase per year for 4 years, for a total of \$14.00 per ton. 2017 is the last year of the tipping fee increase. The tipping fee increase is a direct pass through for Sunshine Disposal based on industry standard calculations, meaning Sunshine Disposal doesn't receive an increase based on the tipping fee and only receives a 1.76% increase per the rate ordinance contract.

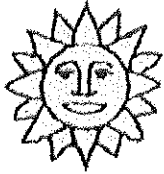

Dear Eric,

As you are aware, Stevens County has notified us that their dump fee at the landfill will be raised from \$71.50 per ton to \$75 per ton effective January 1st, 2017. I have attached Stevens County Resolution 48-2013 which outlines the landfill rate. In contract section 13.4 there is a provision for a disposal fee change. As you are also aware, section 13.7 of our contract provides for a cost of living adjustment the first of April each year. As we have previously discussed, it will be less of a burden and more transparent to have one increase to the residents of your City, rather than two increases in 90 days. Having one increase will help minimize phone calls to both Sunshine Disposal & Recycling and the City.

With that in mind, we have agreed to have one increase effective April 1st 2017. This increase will be inclusive of both the CPI and the disposal fee components, as outlined in section 13.4 and 13.7.

I have prepared a rate sheet that reflects the aforementioned changes. If you have any questions or would like us to attend any meetings regarding the matter please do not hesitate to call. We look forward to continuing to provide service to you and the City of Colville in the future.

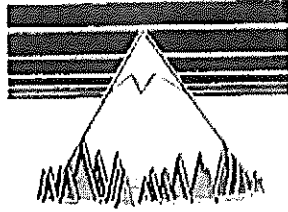

RE: Hearing to Discuss Raising Tipping Fees

Mr. Torre,

The Stevens County Board of County Commissioners (BOCC) held hearings on August 27 and September 10, 2013 to consider a proposal to increase the tipping fees charged at the County's landfill and transfer stations. It was determined from the testimony from those hearings that the County needed to raise the tipping fees at the county's landfill and transfer stations. After deliberation and discussion the BOCC determined that the County would raise the tipping fees at the solid waste disposal facilities. In accordance with the attached resolution signed by the BOCC on September 10th, 2013 the rates will go into effect January 1, 2014.

RCW 70.95.212 requires that: To provide solid waste collection companies with sufficient time to prepare and submit tariffs and rate filings for public comment and commission approval, the owner or operator of a transfer station, landfill, or facility used to burn solid waste shall provide seventy-five days' notice to solid waste collection companies of any change in tipping fees and disposal rate schedules.

WHEREAS, the Board finds that the testimony presented indicates that due to an increase in operational costs which include increases in employee wages, equipment and facility repairs, debt service due to new landfill construction and a decrease in solid waste tonnages.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by that Board of Stevens County Commissioners that Resolution #42-2009 is hereby repealed and the tipping fee per ton at the Stevens County Landfill and the transfer stations should be increased to the following based upon the testimony presented at the hearings; and

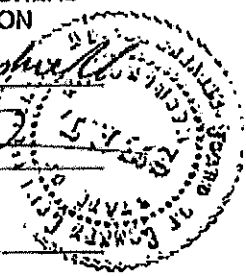


SECTION 3


